Surgical Requirements

Bloodwork

Briarcliff Animal Clinic requires pre- anesthetic blood work that may reveal hidden medical problems that might cause complications with the anesthetic given to your pet.

Age 0-7 years - a Complete Blood Cell Count (CBC) at a cost of \$35.00

Over 7 and up - CBC & Chemistries (BUN, ALT, Glucose, Cr, TP, AP) at a cost of \$105.80

Chemistries and CBC have been completed and supplied for this surgical procedure

Pain Management

It is the ethical standard of this hospital to provide pain management to every pet before, during and after all surgeries. An injection will be administered to your pet prior to surgery and during the procedure to minimize your pet's discomfort. We will also provide oral pain medications for you to give at home.

IV Catheter and fluids are required for all surgeries. Price based on pets weight.

Surgical options

Briarcliff offers traditional surgery and Laser surgery. Laser surgery reduces blood loss, swelling and post-operative pain. Laser surgery cost is based on length of surgery. One of our staff will let you know the cost for your pet's procedure.

Microchips

Microchips, for pet identification, are available at Briarcliff. These chips can be placed in your pet during most surgical procedures, if you choose.

Dentistry

Routine dental cleanings are imperative to maintain your pet’s overall health. Problems include oral infections, heart, and kidney problems. This procedure can be preformed while your pet is sedated for surgery for an additional cost of \$56.80-78.60 for felines and \$89.55-122.75 for canines, depending on tarter build-up, gingivitis development or bone loss. OraVet, an invisible sealant, can be applied after the dental for an additional \$18.35 This product is clinically proven to reduce plaque and tarter formation by prevention bacteria from attaching to the teeth.

Minor Extractions:

If during your pet’s dental teeth need to be extracted, it is much easier on your pet for this to be done while he/she is already under sedation. With your permission, the doctor will determine whether a tooth needs to come out, and it will be done while your pet is sedated. (The costs of extractions are not included in the Cleaning/Polishing Dentistry fee.) *Please note that any major problems found during the dental will be discussed at pick up, and additional necessary procedures will be scheduled for a future visit.
